Representative Fabian, serving his second term, was first elected to the Minnesota House of Representatives in 2010.

He grew up in Fargo, ND, received his Bachelor of Arts degree from Concordia College and his Master's degree from North Dakota State University.

Representative Fabian resides in Roseau, MN with his wife of 38 years, Roxanne. Before coming to St. Paul as a legislator, Representative Fabian spent 34 years as a high school physical education teacher. He also coached high school cross-country and track and continues to be a self-employed crop hail insurance adjuster.

Dan has carried major legislation to reform and speed up the environmental permitting process as well as extending deadlines for implementation of costly standardized septic systems. Dan also chief authored The Lands Bill, which aids residents in resolving state land disputes as well as the purchase and selling of private and state land. Representative Fabian currently serves on the Environment, Natural Resources and Agriculture Finance, and Policy Committees, as well as the Jobs and Economic Development Committee.
