

Senator **Bill Weber** (R) District 22

Senator Weber was elected to his first term in the Minnesota Senate in 2012 and serves all or part of nine counties in the southwest corner of the state. His district has approximately 72 miles of border with South Dakota and over 60 miles with Iowa. He serves on two policy and two finance committees – Environment and Energy; Jobs, Agriculture and Rural Development; E-12 Education Finance; Environment, Economic Development and Ag Finance. In addition, he serves on the Permanent School Lands Trust Committee.

Senator Weber is a native of his district having grown up in Rock County and graduated from the Luverne High School. He went on to business college in professional accounting. He is the owner and president of Jensen Management Service, Inc. a real estate brokerage, appraisal and management firm. Previously, he served sixteen years in local government as a council member and mayor of Luverne.

Bill is married to Barb and they are the parents of two adult children who are married and live in the Twin Cities area of Minnesota and they are the grandparents of Isla Marie.
