Brian Shipley manages the Foreign Policy and Diplomacy Service unit (i.e., Political and Public Affairs) at the Consulate General of Canada in Minneapolis, MN. His responsibilities include advocacy, government relations, and public engagement across the five-state territory of the Upper Midwest (ND, SD, NE, MN, IA), with a focus on economic competitiveness, the border, energy, and the environment.

Before coming to Minneapolis in September 2012, Brian served for three years in the Political section at the Embassy of Canada in Seoul, South Korea. From 2007-09, he worked at the Foreign Affairs and International Trade HQ in Ottawa.

Prior to joining the Government of Canada, Brian was a member of the research faculty in History, at Rutgers, the State University of New Jersey, from 2001-06. He holds a Ph.D. in Canadian history and the history of science from Dalhousie University in Halifax, Nova Scotia; an M.A. from the University of Toronto; and a B. Arts & Sc. from McMaster University in Hamilton, Ontario.
