The Sanford Lab will provide personal protective equipment (coveralls, hardhats, cap lamps, safety glasses, etc.). The temperature will be in the low- to mid-70s at the 4,850-foot level - although comfortable we suggest long sleeves or a light sweater or jacket. Dress casually, but appropriate for a construction site. We ask that you wear long pants - no shorts or skirts will be allowed. Tennis shoes or hiking boots are required - no open-toed shoes or sandals will be allowed. Our tour will include walking down and up two flights of metal stairs. Restrooms are available underground. Cameras are welcome.
