Cliff Graydon was born and raised in Arnaud and has spent the past 40 years farming grain and purebred Charolais cattle. Before entering politics, Cliff was a founding member of the Manitoba Cattle Producers Association and served on its board of directors. He was a member of the Stuartburn Piney Agricultural Development Association and the Prairies East Sustainable Agricultural Initiative, and served as a councillor for the Rural Municipality of Franklin for six years.

Cliff was elected to the Manitoba Legislature in 2007, and has held various critic portfolios during his time in opposition including: MPI; Liquor Control; Lotteries; Gaming; Agriculture; Entrepreneurship, Training and Trade; as well as Healthy Living and Seniors.

In 2016, The Progressive Conservative party was elected to form government in Manitoba. Cliff is presently the Party Whip for the governing Progressive Conservative party. He has also been appointed to the Manitoba Hydro Board.

Cliff and his wife, Rose Ellen, live in Dominion City and have two children, Amy and Warren, a daughter-in-law Venessa and four lovely grandchildren, Bailey, Colby, René, and Avelynne.
