Randy is a Lieutenant with the Sioux Falls Police Department. He is assigned as the Property Crimes and Narcotics Commander and supervises the Sioux Falls Area Drug Task Force (SFADTF). The SFADTF is comprised of agents/detectives from several agencies to include the Sioux Falls Police Department, Minnehaha County Sheriff's Department, South Dakota Division of Criminal Investigation, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms, and the Drug Enforcement Agency. The SFADTF is responsible for the investigation of narcotic crimes in the Sioux Falls metro area.

Randy is from Sioux Falls and has watched Sioux Falls grow over the course of his life and professional career. After graduating high school, he enrolled in college at South Dakota State University in Brookings, South Dakota. He graduated college in 1997 after earning a bachelor's degree in Sociology with a Criminal Justice minor.

The Minnehaha County Sheriff's Department hired him in 1997 and he worked as a Correctional Officer and as a Uniformed Patrol Deputy until 2003. In 2003, he was hired by the Sioux Falls Police Department.

Through the course of his career with the Sioux Falls Police Department, he has held many roles to include being a patrol officer, a field-training officer, and a narcotics detective. He has supervised several specialty units to include the traffic section, our street crimes unit, and now as the Lieutenant in Property Crimes and Narcotics.
