Jack is the fourth generation on a conservation award winning family farm north of Dell Rapids, SD where they raise corn, soybeans, oats, alfalfa, cover crops and grass hay. He has served on the Moody Conservation District Board of Supervisors since 1986 and is chairman of the Board. He is also a past president of the South Dakota Association of Conservation Districts and has served as an officer of the National Association of Conservation Districts from 2008 through 2012.

During the past twenty-five years, the Moody Conservation District has sponsored and implemented several EPA Sec. 319 grants to improve the water quality in the Big Sioux River that flows through Moody County in the SE part of South Dakota. For the past 9 years, they have been the prime sponsor for the Big Sioux River Watershed Project, a 2 million-acre six county water quality improvement project funded through 319 grants to reduce the bacteria and total suspended solids in the Lower Big Sioux River.
