### Professional Driver; Ambassador, Women in Trucking

Kellylynn McLaughlin is a professional Over-The-Road driver and trainer based in Edmond, Oklahoma. In addition to training new drivers, she is actively involved in sharing the “driver” perspective with decision-makers in the industry.
